The Crawfordsville Common Council met on Monday, February 13, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Todd Barton, Clerk-Treasurer – Terri Gadd and City Attorney – Keenan Wilson, Councilman– Ethan Hollander, Councilman– Stan Hamilton, Councilman – Andy Biddle, Councilwoman – Jennifer Lowe, Councilman – Kent Priebe and Councilman – Mike Reidy.

Councilman Hollander led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Reidy led the prayer.

Chairman Barton asked Clerk-Treasurer Gadd to call the roll for purpose of attendance. Councilman Lucas was not present.

Councilman Biddle moved to approve the minutes from the meeting on January 9, 2023. Councilman Hamilton seconded.

Councilman Biddle moved to acknowledge receipt of the monthly financials. Councilman Reidy seconded. Motion passed.

Clerk-Treasurer Gadd called the roll for suggested additions to the agenda. Councilman Biddle and Councilman Reidy had one item.

Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The resolution passed with a unanimous vote.

The third item is a Resolution Authorizing an Intergovernmental Cooperation Agreement between the City of Crawfordsville and Montgomery County, Indiana regarding Combined Dispatch and 911 Public Safety Answering Point Services. Councilman Biddle moved to approve the resolution. Councilman Reidy seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The resolution passed with a unanimous vote.

The fourth item presented First reading of an Ordinance Re-Establishing the Cumulative Capital Development Fund under Indiana Code § 36-9-15.5. Councilman Biddle moved to place the Ordinance on first reading. Councilman Hamilton seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.
