



Crawfordsville Council Meeting Minutes

The Crawfordsville Common Council met on Monday, May 8, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. Present were Mayor Todd Barton, Clerk-Treasurer – Terri Gadd and City Attorney – Kent Minnette, Councilman–Ethan Hollander, Councilman – Andy Biddle, Councilwoman – Jennifer Lowe, Councilman – Kent Priebe, Councilman – Jeff Lucas, Councilman – Stan Hamilton and Councilman – Mike Reidy.

Councilman Hollander led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Councilman Lucas led the prayer.

Chairman Barton asked Clerk-Treasurer Gadd to call the roll for purpose of attendance. All present.

Councilman Reidy moved to approve the minutes from the meeting on April 10, 2023. Councilman Hamilton seconded.

Councilman Biddle moved to acknowledge receipt of the monthly financials. Councilman Reidy seconded. Motion passed.

Clerk-Treasurer Gadd called the roll for suggested additions to the agenda. No additions.

Public Hearing

Mayor Barton opened a public hearing at 6:02 p.m. on an Ordinance to Appropriate from the ARP Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery Fund for Purposes that Fulfill the Intent of the American Rescue Plan Act in Aid of the City's Recovery from the Effects of the COVID-19 Emergency.

Hearing no comments, the hearing was closed at 6:03 p.m.

The third item presented first reading of an Ordinance Amending the Green Power Rider for Services Rendered by Crawfordsville Electric Light & Power. Councilman Biddle moved to place the Ordinance on first reading. Councilman Priebe seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. John Douglas offered comments. Hearing no further comments, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

Traffic, Parking & Safety

The first item presented is the second reading of an Ordinance Vacating Beech Street in Crawfordsville, Indiana. Councilman Hamilton moved to place the Ordinance on second reading. Councilman Biddle seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed second reading with a unanimous vote.

Councilman Hamilton moved to place the Ordinance on second reading. Councilwoman Lowe seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed second reading with a unanimous vote.

Councilman Hamilton moved to place the ordinance on third and final reading and so adopt. Councilman Reidy seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed third and final reading with a unanimous vote.

(Ordinance#14-2023)

The third item presented is the first reading of an Ordinance Vacating a Portion of an Alley in Crawfordsville, Indiana – North-South Alley directly west of 413 Harrison Street. Councilman Hamilton moved to place the Ordinance on first reading. Councilwoman Lowe seconded. Chairman Barton called for comments from the Council and the public. Hearing none, the roll was called for the vote. The ordinance passed first reading with a unanimous vote.

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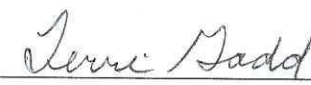
Adjournment
