Board members discussed the 2024 Storm Water Budget. The 2024 Budget is \$747,718. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board member discussed the 2024 Wastewater Budget. The 2024 Budget is \$4,400,528. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

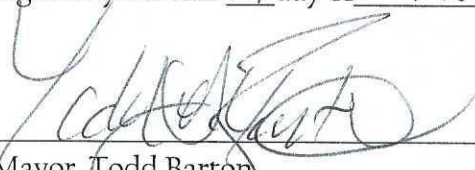

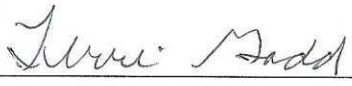
With there being no further business, Erin Corbin moved to adjourn. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
