



## Board of Works and Public Safety Meeting Minutes

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The Board met on Wednesday, March 22, 2023, at 10:00 a.m. with Mayor Barton, Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Also present were Mike McKinney - Wastewater, Mark Cox - Street Department, Aaron Mattingly - Police Department, Scott Busenbark - Fire Department, Fawn Johnson - Park & Rec, Megan Huckstep - Planning Department, John Douglas - CEL&P and Renee Demoret - Mayor's Assistant.

Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from March 15, 2023. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Susan Albrecht moved to approve the claims from March 20, 2023. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

### Old Business

Board members followed up on an unsafe building order for 1100 W. Market Street, owned by Mark Sipe. Barry Lewis, Code Enforcement, informed the Mayor that the repairs were made and was satisfied with the improvements. Mayor Barton made a motion to rescind the unsafe building order. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed quotes received for the Crawfordsville Fire Dept. for a Chevy Equinox. Erin Corbin moved to table the quotes. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

### New Business

Richard Pan, Phi Gamma Delta, came before the board requesting a noise ordinance abatement for April 1<sup>st</sup>. Susan Albrecht moved to approve the request from 8pm-12am. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Betty Sheets, 811 W. Main Street, is requesting to close the alley along her property on April 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> for a tree removal. Erin Corbin moved to approve the alley closure from Main Street until the end of her property, contingent upon weather. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Amanda White, 1001 E. Market Street, is requesting to place a dumpster on the street (Pine Street side) on Friday, March 24 thru Friday, March 31. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Susan George is requesting to place a dumpster at 101 E. Main Street using 2 parking spots beginning Wednesday, March 29<sup>th</sup> for one week. Erin Corbin moved to approve the request, excluding the handicap spot. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Randy Hendrickson, CEL&P, came before the board requesting to place 6 new street lights in Ashton Run. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed street closure requests in regards to the 2023 Strawberry Festival. The requests are the same as past years with no changes. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Strand & Associates for an engineering assessment of 150 S. This agreement is in the amount of \$23,000. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Historic Landmarks Foundation of Indiana. Megan Huckstep, Planning Director, said this is to allow annual preservation activities and quality development of the historic landmarks. This agreement is in the amount of \$6,000. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a quick deed claim for 412 W. North Street. This is to release the property to Habitat for Humanity of Montgomery County, Inc. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members opened bids in regards to the Community Crossings Paving Program.

DC Construction Services – lump sum \$872,462.57

Midwest Paving – lump sum \$926,226.42

Reith Riley – lump sum \$996,363.30

Mayor Barton moved to take the bids under advisement. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

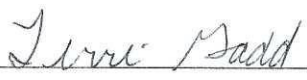
#### Adjournment
