Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Thomas P. Miller & Associates for a Career Academy Feasibility Study. This agreement is in the amount of \$48,500 and will be paid with ARP grants. This is for all three school districts in Montgomery County and Western Boone. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

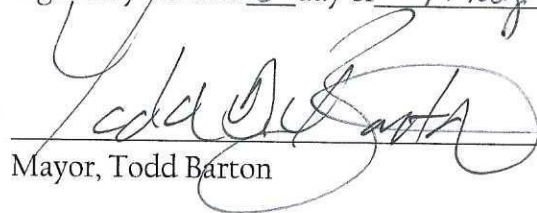

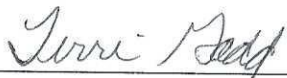
With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
