The Board met on Wednesday, January 24, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. with Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from January 17, 2024. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a request from Mark Cox, Street Commissioner, for the purchase of a 2024 ACS scrap grapple bucket attachment. This purchase is in the amount of \$27,345. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed quotes received for the Wastewater Department for a 2024 F-150 Dodge crew cab truck. They received three quotes. Heartland Ford in the amount of \$45,479, York Chevrolet in the amount of \$44,003.25 and York Chrysler in the amount of \$41,743. Troy McKinney requested they accept the quote from York Chrysler. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Crawfordsville Main Street. This agreement is the same as past years with the exception of compensation in the amount of \$82,000 and an additional \$5,030 for landscaping costs. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a letter of engagement for appraisals to be completed by Valbridge Property Advisors. This is for properties owned by the city located at 508 John Street/ 701 College Ave. and E. South Blvd. The appraisals are in the amount of \$3,800 for both. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

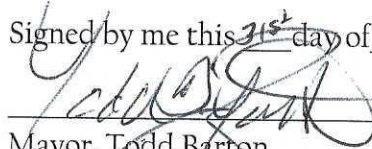
