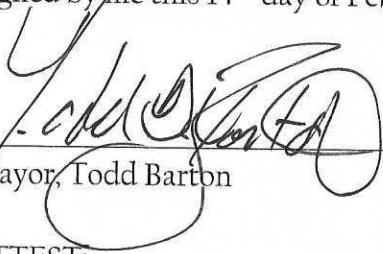
Adjournment

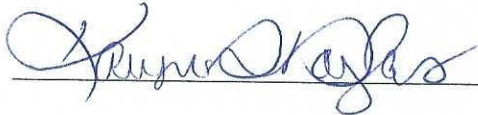
