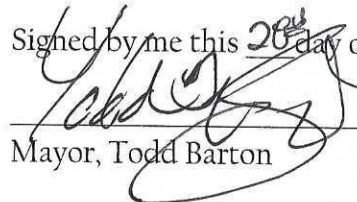
Adjournment

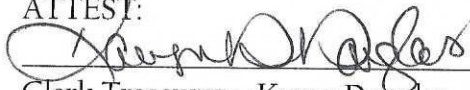
