Board members discussed a proposal from HWC Engineering for an updated ADA and Title VI Plan. This is a requirement from the state for grant funding. This agreement is billed hourly not to exceed \$38,000. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a change order for Lincoln Park. This change is to add fencing between the pickle ball courts with a \$15,000 increase. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a maintenance agreement for the Crawford Fountain from Smock Fansler Corporation. This is a 2 year agreement with year 1 being in the amount of \$9,051 and year 2 in the amount of \$10,421. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

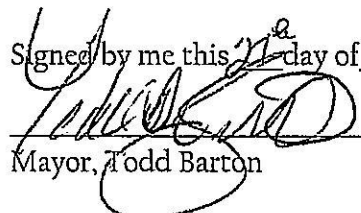

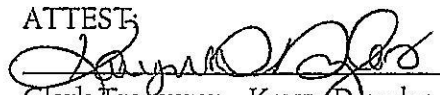
With there being no further business, Erin Corbin moved to adjourn. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
