The Board met on Wednesday, April 24, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. with Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from April 17, 2024. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Paul Pfledderer came before the board with requests in regards to the 2024 Strawberry Festival. The requests are the same as past years and will take place on June 14, 15 and 16. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Morgan Vesey came before the board requesting to close Pike Street at Pike Place on Saturday, June 22nd from 2-9:30 pm for Pride Festival. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Mark Cox, Street Commissioner, requested to surplus a portable lift. The lift is very old and there is no model number or information provided. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a quote from Tom's Marine for a 2024 Polaris in the amount of \$29,193.31 for the Crawfordsville Fire Department. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members opened bids for the 231 water extension. Two bids were received, Price Excavating in the amount of \$1,046,534 and Plant Brothers Excavating in the amount of \$1,022,050. Mayor Barton moved to take the bids under advisement. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a purchase agreement between the City and Christine Demoret & Carri Carrell in regards to the Sugar Creek erosion grant for the vacant lot between 512 and 700 Wayne Avenue (parcel #54-07-31-224-006.000-030). The agreement is in the amount of \$11,900. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

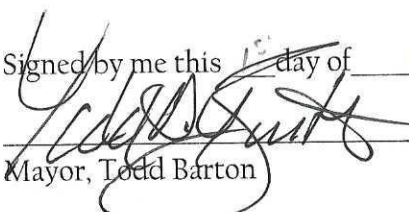
