The Board met on Wednesday, May 1, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. with Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Also present were Karyn Douglas - Clerk Treasurer, Fawn Johnson - Park & Rec, Kiley Cornelius - Wastewater, Mark Cox - Street Department, Paul Miller - Fire Department, Aaron Mattingly - Police Department, Megan Huckstep - Planning Department, Allison Huenemann - CEL&P and Renee Demoret - Mayor's Assistant.

Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from April 24, 2024. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Susan Albrecht moved to approve the claims from April 29, 2024. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Public Hearing

Mayor Barton opened a public hearing at 10:01 am to surplus and dispose of real property specifically parcel #54-10-05-112-129.000-303, 508 John Street. There were no comments. Hearing closed at 10:01 am.

Old Business

Board members discussed the bids received last week for the 231 water extension and a resolution awarding the bid to Price Excavating. Due to the urgency of the project Price Excavating was the best choice in the amount of \$1,046,534.

New Business

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Price Excavating for the 231 water extension. This agreement is in the amount of \$1,046,534. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a work order agreement between the City and DES for construction management for the 231 water extension project. This agreement is in the amount of \$9,124.37. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Board members were to open bids for the purchase and sale of parcel #54-10-05-112-129.000-030, 508 John Street. There were no bids received.

Board members discussed a resolution approving the Crawfordsville Sidewalk Replacement Program. This will be a shared cost program paid from the American Rescue Plan. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members received quotes for demolition work at 1201 E. Elmore Street. Jeff Davenport, Building Inspector, reached out to three companies and heard back from two. Neal Excavating, LLC in the amount of \$96,720 and W. Enterprises in the amount of \$96,600. Susan Albrecht moved to approve the low bid received from W. Enterprises. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.
