The Board met on Wednesday, May 22, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. with Erin Corbin, Mayor Barton and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from May 8, 2024. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a purchase agreement request from the Crawfordsville Fire Department for the purchase of a 2022 atv trailer in the amount of \$3,845.00. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a change order for pedestrian safety project on Wabash Ave. This change is to add panels to be ada compliant. The change order is in the amount of \$4,755.50. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Greater Indianapolis Chamber of Commerce. This agreement is in relation to the Read funds in the amount of \$192,100 designated to the Masonic Cornerstone and allow the City to administer the project. Erin Corbin moved to approve. 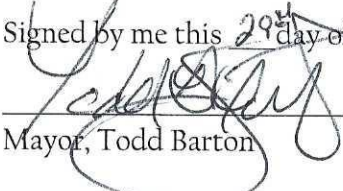

Adjournment

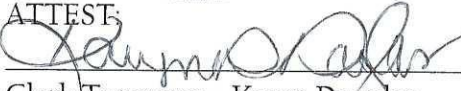
With there being no further business, Erin Corbin moved to adjourn. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
