The Board met on Wednesday, May 29, 2024, at 10:00 a.m. with Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Arts Council of Indianapolis. \$25,000 will be paid by a READI grant, \$10,000 will be paid by the Community Foundation, \$8,333 will be paid by the Arts Council and the City will be responsible for \$6,667. Board members discussed a request from HWC for contract addendums in regards to additional construction administration for Lincoln and Brickyard Park. Lincoln is not to exceed \$6,000 and Brickyard \$4,000. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

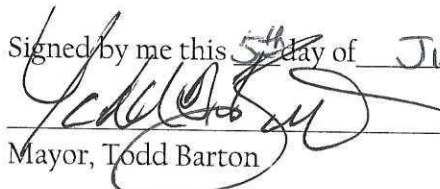
