Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

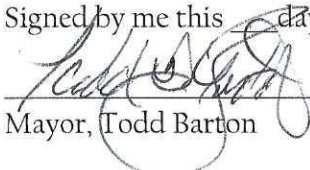
