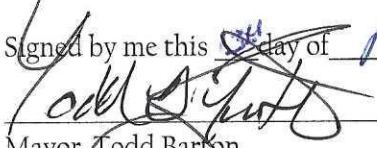
Department Heads

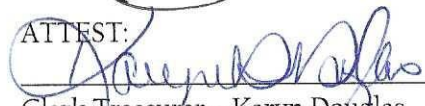
Adjournment
