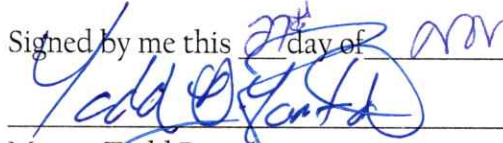
Department Heads

Adjournment

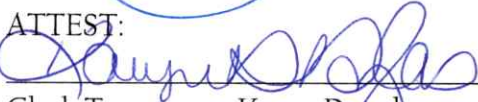
With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
