January 22, 2025 at 5:00 PM Meeting Minutes

The City of Crawfordsville Historic Preservation Commission met in special session at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, January 22, 2025 in the Common Council Chambers of the Municipal Building. Members present were: Sue Lucas, Thomas Meeks, Thomas Neal, and Emily Race. Members Owen Bennett and Aaron Hurt were not in attendance. Also in attendance were: Megan Huckstep, Director of Planning & Building Services; Tommy Kleckner of Indiana Landmarks; Noah Nobbe of Indiana Landmarks; and Kathryn Fisher, Executive Assistant, Planning & Building Services.

Sue Lucas called the meeting to order at 5:05 p.m.

The January 22, 2025 agenda was presented for consideration. Thomas Neal moved to approve the agenda as presented. Emily Race seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Meeting minutes from November 20, 2024 were presented for consideration. Emily Race made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Thomas Neal seconded. Motion passed 4-0.

Becky Hankins entered the meeting at 5:07 p.m.

The Commission received the financial report. Planning Director Megan Huckstep noted that grant commitments for 105-107 and 109 E Main Street are reflected in the report. Emily Race made a motion to approve the financial report. Thomas Meeks seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Becky Hankins called for election of officers. Thomas Neal moved to nominate Becky Hankins as President, Sue Lucas as Vice President, and Emily Race as Treasurer. Emily Race seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Under items of new business, Tommy Kleckner of Indiana Landmarks presented a proposed 2025 Work Plan for consideration. After reviewing the document, Mr. Kleckner recommended adoption of the 2025 Work Plan at the February meeting.

Ms. Huckstep reported that the Loan Program Document updates were still in progress.

Coming forward with public comment, Judi Kleine offered an update on the Masonic Cornerstone. Thomas Meeks provided an update on the Carriage House renovations at the Lew Wallace study. Sue Lucas welcomed the new Main Street Director, Jami Harrington.
