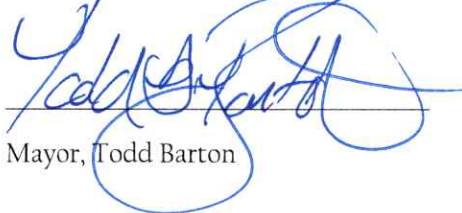
Redevelopment Commission - 2 appointments/1 yr. term - Councilman Hamilton nominated Conrad Harvey
