Board members were presented with the ADA Transition Plan. This is a study for federal funds and the first public presentation for comments.

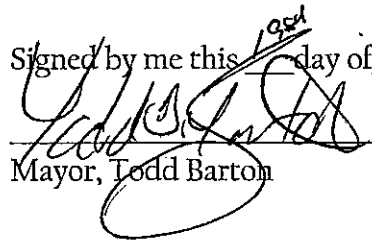

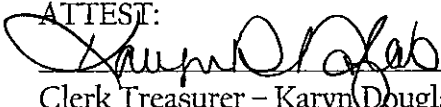
With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
