The Board met on Wednesday, April 30, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. with Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Also present were Fawn Johnson - Park & Rec, Troy McKinney - Wastewater, Mark Cox - Street Department, Aaron Mattingly - Police Department, Katie Fisher - Planning Department, Allison Huemman - CELP&P, - Paul Miller - Fire Department and Renee Demoret - Mayor's Assistant.

Susan Albrecht moved to approve the minutes from April 23, 2025. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a request from Price Excavating to close Grant Avenue between Walter Remley and S. Boulevard for one day for a water main leak. The closure will begin Thursday, May 1 at 8:30 am. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a request from Tim Jones to block half of the sidewalk in front of 220 E. Market Street for one week beginning Thursday, May 1 for work on the front of the building. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a request from Alex Runner to place a dumpster at 126 E. Main Street beginning Friday, May 2 thru Monday, May 5. The dumpster can be placed in the front of the building using 2 parking spaces. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Mark Cox, Street Commissioner, requesting approval for a purchase of a Line Laser Paint Machine. The quote from Sherwin Williams is in the amount of \$15,185. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and Commonwealth Engineering. This is a 5 year agreement not to exceed \$40,000. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Brandy Allen, Director of Operations and Community Development, came before the board with a change order for the Shelly Drain Project. The change order is in the amount of \$35,000. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

Mayor Barton moved to take the proposals under advisement. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

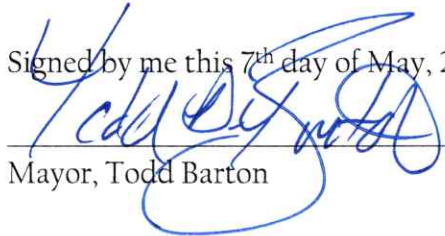

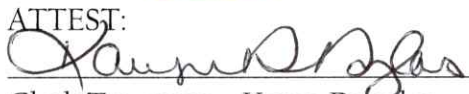
With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
