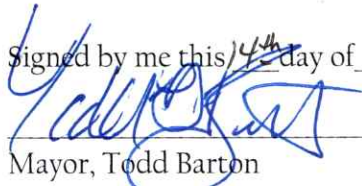
Mayor Barton moved to take the bids under advisement. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.
