Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from May 21, 2025. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Michele Borden came before the board with a route approval request for the 2025 Veteran's Day Parade. The parade route will be the same route as the annual Christmas parade. Board members discussed a variance request for Lux54 apartments. The variance is broken down into 3 parts.

- Removal of sediment forebays. Mayor Barton moved to grant the variance request. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.
- Pond Emergency Drainage System. Mayor Barton moved to grant the variance request. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.
- Keeping 12' of clear roadway during storm events. Mayor Barton moved to grant the variance request. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed an agreement between the City and RJL Solutions for government affairs and strategic communication services. This agreement is effective June 2025 to March 2026 in the amount to not exceed \$5,000. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

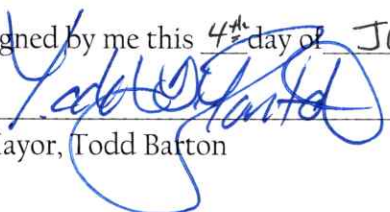
Department Heads

Adjournment

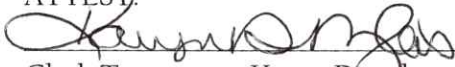
With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
