Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from June 4, 2025. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

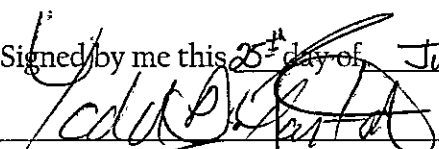

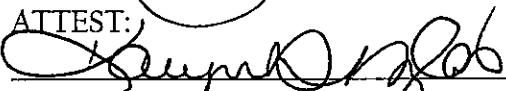
