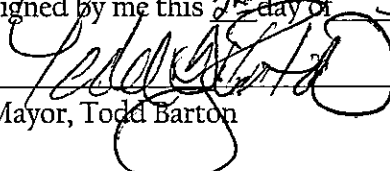
Department Heads
