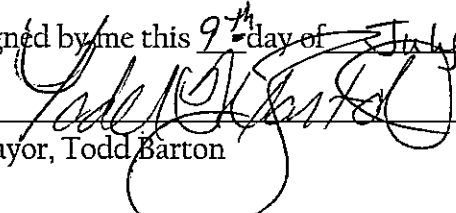

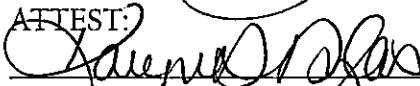
Adjournment
