Board members discussed a Transfer from Category to Category for the Crawfordsville Police Department. This is a transfer from 1101.009.392 Police Reserves to 1101.009.230 Vehicles & Other repairs in the amount of \$5,550. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Mayor Barton seconded. Motion passed.

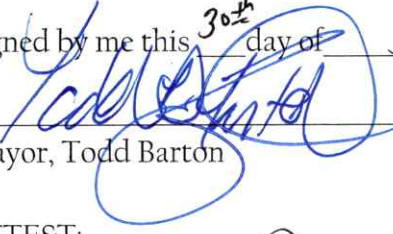

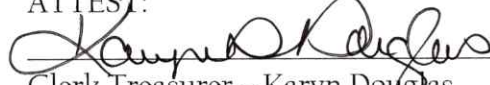
