The Board met on Wednesday, August 27, 2025, at 10:00 a.m. with Erin Corbin, Susan Albrecht, Mayor Barton, and Kent Minnette - City Attorney present. Erin Corbin moved to approve the minutes from August 13, 2025. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Chris Moore, Storm Water, came before the board requesting to close the Broadway Street at Ladoga Rd in regards to a storm line on Thursday, August 28 and as needed on Friday, August 29 Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed bid acceptance for joint City/County project related to the former landfill cap restoration. The 2 bids received one from Price Excavating in the amount of \$74,250 and JS McCullough Excavating, LLC in the amount of \$62,000. Mayor Barton moved to accept the bid from JS McCullough Excavating, LLC. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

Board members discussed a Work Order Agreement between the City, County, and DES Engineering for seeding following cap restoration project at former landfill. This agreement is in the amount of \$9,800 and will be split 50/50 between City & County. Susan Albrecht moved to approve. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed.

Barry Lewis, Code Enforcement Officer, came before the board with a mowing work order request for 605 Tuttle Avenue, owned by University Bank. Erin Corbin moved to approve. Susan Albrecht seconded. Motion passed.

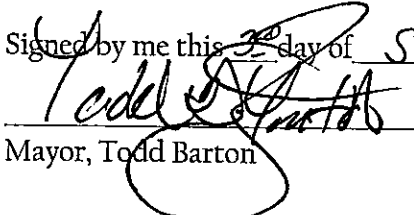
Department Heads

Adjournment

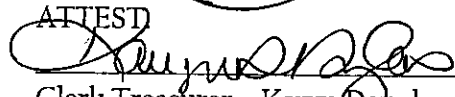
With there being no further business, Susan Albrecht moved to adjourn. Erin Corbin seconded. Motion passed and the meeting was adjourned.
