### February 18, 2026 at 5:00 PM Meeting Minutes

The City of Crawfordsville Historic Preservation Commission met in special session at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 18, 2026 in the Common Council Chambers of the Municipal Building. Members present were: Becky Hankins, Emily Race, Thomas Meeks, Aaron Hurt, and Nolan Eller. Members Sue Lucas and Steve Galegor were not in attendance. Others in attendance were: Megan Huckstep, Director of Planning & Building Services; Noah Nobbe of Indiana Landmarks; and Katie Fisher, Executive Assistant, Planning & Building Services.

Becky Hankins called the meeting to order at 5:00 p.m.

The February 18, 2026 agenda was presented for consideration. Emily Race moved to approve the agenda as presented. Aaron Hurt seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Minutes from January 28, 2026 were presented for consideration. Emily Race moved to approve the minutes as presented. Thomas Meeks seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

The Commission considered the financial report. Planning Director, Megan Huckstep, noted there have been no changes. Emily Race moved to receive and acknowledge the financial report. Thomas Meeks seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

With no items of old business, the Commission considered a Certificate of Appropriateness submitted by Jon Anderson for 111-113 S Water Street. Mr. Anderson was not present at the meeting. Noah Nobbe, Indiana Landmarks, presented the Staff Report reviewing the project in three components: replacement of two unoriginal front porches, addition of two new rear decks, and replacement of unoriginal windows on side and rear facades. Mr. Nobbe reported no major concerns for any of the components. The Commission then engaged in discussion. After deliberation, Emily Race moved to approve the Certificate of Appropriateness at 111-113 S Water Street. Thomas Meeks seconded. Motion passed 5-0.

Continuing with items of Certificate of Appropriateness Review, Planning Director Megan Huckstep provided an update from Jon Oliver concerning 117 E Market Street.

Under items of new business, Secretary Katie Fisher reviewed updates to the Historic Preservation Commission page of the City of Crawfordsville website. After reviewing the changes, Ms. Fisher noted the feedback for additional updates.



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Under miscellaneous items, Ms. Huckstep reminded the Commission that they would be moving from OnBoard to the CivicPlus Agenda and Meeting Management system. She also noted updates to a Masonic Temple door and the Clore Insurance sign installation.

Judi Kleine came forward offering an update on the Masonic project.

With no further business, Emily Race moved to adjourn the meeting at 5:44 p.m. Thomas Meeks seconded. Motion passed 5-0.
